Introduction: Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.

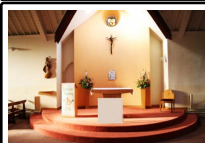

Sundays 1pm to 5.30pm

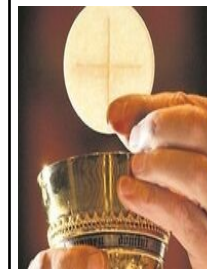
ST. BRENDAN'S CHURCH, CURRAHEEN: open daily from 10am to 5pm
